

Camper Van Kit Quick Guide

1. Rules

The camper van kit can be booked for up to 8 days. It is booked as a separate entity on our booking system. You pay £12 per 24 hours. (Up to 24hrs = £12, 24-48hrs = £24, etc.) Remember to book Berlingo XTR at the same time.

Fair usage policy: We aim to distribute the use of the camper van kit fairly. We want to let everyone have the chance to use it. And at the same time, we want to enable people to plan ahead, and know their booking is reliable. It is up to the manager to administer this policy using common sense in relation to each situation that arises. Some guidelines to aid this are:

- If a member has already used the CV kit in the last 2 months, then a second member who has not used it for the last 2 months has a higher priority. If that person wants to book the same dates, then the first member may be asked to cancel their booking. The second person needs to give reasonable notice, e.g. at least 2 weeks.
- Priority will be given to bookings made well in advance, as opposed to more spontaneous bookings. You can mark one and only one booking as PRIORITY in the Destination field to indicate it should not be the one to get cancelled in case of conflicting needs.

2. What to take

Moray Carshare provides the following items, **stored as part of the kit:**

- 2 plastic plates, bowls and cups
- 2 sets of metal knives, forks, spoons & teaspoons
- 1 small kettle
- 1 cloth for wiping surfaces
- 1 washing up basin & brush & sponge & small washing up liquid & drip tray
- Cooking fuel, for which you will be charged £3 per bottle (about 7 meals)
- 1 box long matches: please **buy a**

replacement if necessary.

You need to **bring your own:**

- sheets, sleeping bags & pillows
- pots & pans
- cooking implements & chopping board
- dish towels

And you need to **fill up the water container** before you leave. Please make sure the lid is screwed on tightly at all times, as it can easily fall over when you are driving and spill water.

3. How to use the kit

1. The kit is heavy, so it needs 2 to people to lift it into the car. Before moving it, make sure the cooker drawer on the left of the kit is locked. The lock is on the right side of the drawer. Push the hole down to lock it. Once unlocked, you open the drawer by giving it a push from the front. Push the kit in so it is about 3 cm from the edge of the boot:



2. Next we advise you to take out the middle back seat and leave it at home, so you have more luggage space. Then you need to fold down the back seats and secure the kit in the car, so it cannot slide backwards or forwards, using the two wedges shown here. The large slat in the wedge fits over the black plastic ridge that protrudes from the side of the car. Screw the disc on the camper van kit into the wedge hole nearest the front of the car. You may need to move the kit a little forward or backwards to get these to fit. Use the screwdriver from the drawer under the cooker to firmly tighten the screws all the way into the circular indents in the wedges as shown here:

3. When you want to sleep, pull both front seats as far forward as they go, then tilt them a little forwards as shown below:



4. Then unfold the base frame, so it looks as shown to the right. And then you can lay the mattresses on top of the frame, and put up the blinds from the large black plastic bag to keep out the light if you wish.



5. To use the table, pull out the steel table leg held in a large clip at the end of the kit nearest the front of the car. Take the table top off the middle of the kit. Then place the leg in its base, and the table on the leg as shown to the right:

6. To use the stove, pull the drawer all the way out, then lock it using the bolt at the end of the drawer nearest the front of the car, as shown below:



7. The instructions for using the stove are on page 17 of the Dometic booklet that should be under the cooker. Please follow these carefully.

8. If you wish to use the boot tent – kept in the large green bag - a kind of awning that can be attached so it creates an extra space beyond the end of the boot, please carefully watch the 3rd video at:

3. Taking care of the kit

It is your responsibility to thoroughly clean the kit when you are finished with it, so it is completely clean and welcoming for the next user.

If you use the boot tent, you need to dry it out completely before you fold it up and put it away.
